Well Done we thought. Then to our surprise we were awarded **3 SPECIAL AWARDS**.

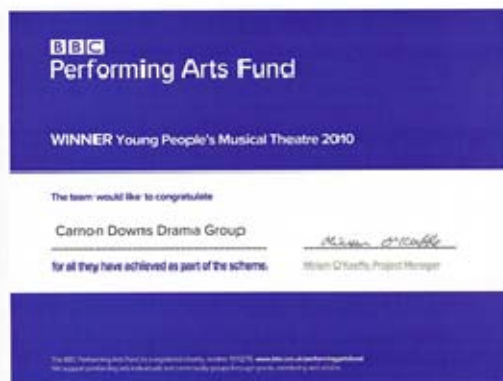
One for the **FIGHTING MACHINES IN "THE WAR OF THE WORLDS"**
